

**STOP HURRYING & WORRYING!** In Lewis Carrol's classic *Alice's* Adventures in Wonderland, we see Alice confronting the white rabbit. The rabbit scurries quickly by proclaiming, "Oh dear! I shall be too late!" In this statement we have two of the greatest problems of people today: worry and hurry.

We live in a world of uncertainty and most people's reaction is to excessively worry. We also live in a fast-paced world in which most think they must always be in a hurry just to keep up. But living in these ways makes our lives unsettled and miserable.

When Korah wrote Psalm 46, he addressed the solution to both of these problems. He opened by stating, "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore, we will not fear..." The more we trust in God and that He is strong and in control, we will fear and worry less.

He ends the Psalm by saying, "Be still, and know that I am God...God...is our refuge." It is important to stop from time to time and reflect upon God. Take some time to meditate upon the Scriptures, contemplate God's awesomeness, and soak in His love. It is then that we will see that we do not need to worry or hurry so much—maybe even at all.
