Just Between Us

IN THE HEART OF WINTER! As we enter the month of February, we enter one of the coldest months of the year... but good news... spring is less than seven weeks away!! February is also known as a great month to prepare for the great days ahead! Our young people are busy preparing for the upcoming Bible Bowl on March 2-3 here at Richland Road. Make sure to be present on Sunday, February 25, at 9:45 AM for the Bible Bowl Preview... Also, preparations are being made for the weekend of the **Bible Bowl** – we are expecting over 400 in worship on **March 3.** In February, we will begin making preparations for our Friends Day, Church Camp, Vacation Bible School, and so much more! However, the most important is that we must all be preparing our hearts and lives to please the Lord!

DID YOU NOTICE IT WAS MISSING? How often is a building removed, a sign taken down, a tree cut down, and you drive by it for weeks on end before you realize it is missing? But then, one day, it dawned on you it was missing. Your eyes were opened. You wonder how many times you have missed it. Unfortunately, that has happened to me several times. If I missed the obvious, it makes me wonder about other things like...

Guests at church. How many times do I walk by unfamiliar faces in worship? Maybe I'm in a hurry to teach my class... or preach... or talk to people I love... or leave for lunch. And there they are. People who have come for the first or second time. People who are in a church that they've never been to. People who don't know a soul (and they certainly don't know what Bible class to attend), and I pass them up.

Lost folks. Perhaps the person in front of me in the check-out line at Rite Aid, the waitress at Red Lobster, the check-out lady at Walmart, or the young father who attends worship services every Sunday. People who don't know the gospel, people who've never obeyed Jesus in baptism, people who would become Christians if somebody would just ask them. And I pass them up.

People in need. Are my eyes shut (and, consequently, my heart) to the world's hurting people? The young single mother who's living below the poverty level? The college student who can't make his car payment? The divorcee who struggles to put food on the table? The middle-aged couple who is dealing with a child who's a drug addict or alcoholic? How many times do I pass by those in trouble without offering a helping hand?

I'm reminded of an Old Testament story. When Elisha and his servant were surrounded by the enemy, the servant was scared. He went to Elisha and asked, "What shall we do?" Elisha wanted him to see the strength and protection of God. So, he prayed, "O Lord, open his eyes so that he may see" (II Kings 6:17). I pray, "O Lord, open our eyes that we may see"... guests at church, lost folks, people in need... and even a missing tree.

IF YOU LIVE TO SEE ANOTHER DAY? You probably have heard the question, "If you died today/tomorrow, do you know without a doubt you would go to heaven?" It is a good, thought-provoking question that everyone needs to consider. There is another question that I hope you would also consider, "If you wake up tomorrow, do you have a clear plan for using the day to honor Christ by the way you will use it?" When Jesus talked about what would happen after death, he asked people to think about what they had done for people who were sick, cold, hungry, and homeless. He didn't ask about the sorts of things we tend to have on our lists. He wanted to know about the fruits of righteousness. So, Lord willing, when you awake tomorrow, ask yourself, "Do you have a clear plan for using the day to honor Christ by the way you will use it?"


