Just Between Us

WELCOME TO RICHLAND ROAD! We have been preparing and looking forward to hosting the 38th Annual Miami Valley Bible Bowl over the past year! We are blessed to have 33 Bible Bowl Teams participating this weekend from 13 congregations. Our goal is that Christ is glorified throughout this weekend! We admire all the hard work that has been put in by the different teams to learn and even memorize the first 20 **chapters** of the book of **Exodus**. We also appreciate the countless hours of the parents and coaches who have encouraged, challenged, and quizzed the young people to help them prepare for this weekend! We appreciate the dedication of Brian Driver and his helpers, who diligently spearhead this wonderful endeavor each year. We are also thankful for the many members of Richland Road who have worked tirelessly to make this weekend special for everyone participating. In addition, we appreciate our elders who have been supportive of this awesome endeavor! We want to remind all those participating in the Bible Bowl and their families that there is a meal in the fellowship hall immediately after the 11:00 AM worship service.

EXODUS: THE BOOK OF DELIVERANCE. The book of Exodus is about saying Goodbye to bondage and Hello to blessing! So many people today, both young and old, are living in bondage just like the children of Israel did in Egypt, rather than experiencing God's blessing! There's no blessing in bondage and no bondage in blessing! God not only wants to break the bondage and set you free... but He can! In fact, He's the only One who can! That's what the book of Exodus is all about. The name "exodus" means "the way out." It tells you the way out of bondage by simply obeying God's will! That's why God gave us the book of Exodus! To show us how to exit from the life of bondage and enter the life of blessing!

WHAT ARE THE ODDS? Did you know that you have a one in 222,000 chance of death by a lightning strike? Your odds of winning the Powerball lottery are only one in 292 million. The odds of being born on Leap Day, Feb. 29, is 1 in 1,461. Starting next Sunday, I will begin a series of lessons investigating a number of biblical prophecies from the Old Testament that would be impossible for Jesus to fulfill unless He was God himself! Many of these prophecies about Jesus were prophesized 500 to 700 years before he came. Anyone can make predictions; getting them fulfilled is another story. The more detailed the prophecy, the less probable it will come to pass. There are over 300 prophecies about Jesus in the Old Testament. A number of years ago, Peter W. Stoner and Robert C. Newman wrote a book entitled **Science Speaks.** The book was based on the science of probability and vouched for by the American Scientific Affiliation. It set out the odds of any one man in all of history, fulfilling even only eight of the 60 major prophecies (and 270 ramifications) fulfilled by the life of Christ. The probability that Jesus of Nazareth could have fulfilled even eight such prophecies would be only 1 in 1017. That's 1 in 100,000,000,000,000,000. Stoner claims that that amount of silver dollars would be enough to cover the face of the entire state of Texas two feet deep. Now I've been to Texas. Texas is a very big state. Who in his right mind would suppose that a blindfolded man, heading out of Dallas by foot in any direction, would be able, on his very first attempt, to pick up one specifically marked silver dollar out of 100,000,000,000,000? There is no way to explain the Bible's ability to predict the future unless you see God as the author! Please plan on joining us each Sunday in March as we explore five different prophesizes that relate to the last week of Jesus! What are the odds?
