

Just Between Us

WELCOME GUEST! If you are visiting with us today, we are so glad you have accepted our invitation or made a special effort to be with us. During the assembly, we would love for you to fill out the "Welcome Friends" sheet when it is passed down your row. At the 11:00 AM service during the sermon, a "Children's Bible Hour" is available for children 2 years old through kindergarten located in room 5 at the front left side of the auditorium, and a "Junior Worship" for first grade through 4th grade is available in Room 11, which can be found at the end of the hall where the restrooms are. Also, parents, feel free to use the nursery just off the foyer. Again, thank you so much for coming our way today!

PRAISE GOD! CHRIST IS RISEN FROM THE DEAD! One of the underrated verses on the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ is Acts 26:26. Easy to remember-26:26. The apostle Paul is on trial before King Agrippa and Governor Festus. He is giving his witness, explaining why he is living the very life he once fought against, and then transitions into the message of the gospel he now preaches. Paraphrasing, Paul says, "I am preaching this message to those at Damascus, then to Jerusalem and Judea, and then to anyone who would listen, even the Gentiles. I told them they should repent and turn to God. So why am I on trial? I'm being tried for preaching nothing other than the very things that Moses and the prophets predicted, that the Messiah would suffer and RISE FROM THE DEAD and proclaim salvation to the Jews and the Gentiles." At this point, Festus intervened, "Paul, you are out of your mind! Your great learning is driving you insane." "You have completely lost it!" Acts 26:25-26 then records, "I am not insane, Most Excellent Festus. What I am saying is true and reasonable. The King is familiar with these things, and I can speak freely to him. I am convinced that none of this has escaped his notice..." Watch this. Here it comes, "BECAUSE IT WAS NOT **DONE IN A CORNER."** Indeed, Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection were not done in a corner. These were not secret events observed only by a few people sworn to secrecy and cover-up. He was buried by the very people who had crucified him with his followers looking on, and his resurrected body was seen by hundreds of people in different times and places (I Corinthians 15:18). Check out these evidences of the resurrection of Jesus:

- **The empty tomb.** The body disappeared despite the presence of Roman guards.
- The silence of the Jews and the Romans. If they knew where the body was, they could have stopped the spread of the gospel message in its tracks. They couldn't because they didn't know despite numerous efforts to find it.
- The transformation of the disciples and followers of Jesus. Peter, for instance, went from cowardly denying Jesus to boldly proclaiming his resurrection just a few weeks later on the Day of Pentecost when the church began in Acts 2.
- The consistent testimony of Jesus' followers and previous unbelievers. Many unbelievers, including the speaker (Paul) of this account in Acts 26, changed the world forever with their consistent testimony of the resurrection.
- The persecution and eventually martyrdom of the believers. Eleven of the twelve original disciples died a violent martyr's death because of their message. Tens of thousands of other converted Christians were disowned by Jewish families, persecuted, imprisoned, or murdered for their beliefs. One does not die for a lie.

And that's just the tip of the iceberg for evidence of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, Christians, rejoice this Easter that you have a firm message of faith, hope, and love on which to center your life for now and forevermore. This is not simply positive thinking and most definitely is not "pie-in-the-sky-byeand-bye" thinking. - Russell
