

THE IMPORTANCE OF WEEKLY COMMUNION. One of the first things visitors to Churches of Christ notice is the weekly observance of communion. Most churches, both denominational and nondenominational, rarely observe communion because it takes too much time away from the service. Their goal is to have a streamlined 60 min. service, almost exclusively focusing on the preacher and a few reasonably talented musicians. Weekly communion is only practiced by a handful of churches: Catholics, Greek Orthodox, Restoration movement churches (Churches of Christ and Christian churches), and some independent churches. Why do we practice weekly communion? There are both BIBLICAL and HISTORICAL reasons:

- 1. The New Testament historical account of the original church in Acts indicates the church observed communion every time they met (Acts 20:7; I Corinthians 11:20; Acts 2:42).
- 2. Weekly communion ensures that the gospel is proclaimed weekly, irrespective of the sermon content. Paul emphasized that every time we take communion, we are proclaiming the Lord's death until He comes (I Corinthians 11:26).
- 3. The early church practiced weekly communion long after the apostles had passed away, according to multiple historians. Justin Martyr, in 155 A.D., wrote one of the most detailed accounts of a typical church worship assembly: "On the day called Sunday, all who live in cities or in the country gather to be in one place, and the memoirs of the apostles or the writings of the prophets are read, as long as time permits; then, when the reader has ceased, the president verbally instructs and exhorts to the imitation of these good things. Then we all rise together and pray, and, as we before said, when our prayer is ended, bread and wine and water are brought..." (The First Apology, chapter 65).

We are committed to taking time every first day of the week to remember the Lord's death, burial, and resurrection with the sacred observance of communion.
