**THANK YOU** for the cards, flowers, and messages of words of comfort at the passing of my sister Janie Whitworth who passed away recently while we were on vacation. Janie was my oldest sister, but more than anything, a child of God. Until her health failed, she was a very active member of the Denton Church of Christ in Denton, Texas. When Covid hit, she began to watch our service on YouTube every Sunday. Throughout the years, she was a great encouragement to me as a preacher.

NEVER TO LATE TO FINISH THE RACE. In 1912, marathon runner Shizo Kanakuri was chosen to represent Japan in the Summer Olympics in Stockholm. He began the race with the rest of the runners but, along the way, was overcome with heat. He stopped for refreshment but stayed a little too long -- more than an hour. It was now, he thought, too late to get back in the race. He took a train to his hotel and caught a boat back home, too ashamed to tell anyone he was leaving. For more than 50 years, Shizo was listed as a missing person in Sweden until a journalist finally found him; he had spent the last several decades living a quiet life in southern Japan. In 1966, the Swedish Public Television network called him with an offer: Would you like to finish your run? The 85-year-old Kanakuri accepted and traveled to Stockholm to finish the race he had started so many years before. This time, he did cross the finish line; his final time was 54 years, 8 months, 6 days, 8 hours, 32 minutes, and 20.3 seconds. Our reward is not for starting the race; it's for finishing it. We already know that. As Paul said in his farewell, "I consider my life worth nothing to me, if only I may finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me..." (Acts 20:24). Have you guit the race? Remember, it's never too late to get back in the race. You can start running again today. The finish line is still where it used to be. - Russell
