Patience: Patience is waiting calmly without getting grumpy. Like waiting for cookies to bake or for your turn on the swing!

Kindness: Kindness is like sprinkling magic dust of niceness wherever you go. It's helping friends, sharing toys, and saying sweet words. **Goodness:** Goodness is doing what's right and being a hero in everyday life. Like

picking up trash or helping a friend in need.

Faithfulness: Faithfulness is being trustworthy and sticking by your friends and family no matter what. It's like being a loyal sidekick!

Gentleness: Gentleness is being soft and careful, like handling delicate flowers. It's using gentle words and actions with everyone.

Self-Control: Self-control is like having a superhero cape that helps you make good choices. It's saying "no" to things that aren't good for you and "yes" to things that make you stronger.

There is an important distinction to be made here: many times, people think the Fruits of the Spirit are a list of things they have to work on in order to be good Christians. I don't think that's what the verse is actually saying, though. Can you imagine trying to work harder at something like having peace? That seems to me like something that would only end in frustration. These verses are much more encouraging when you realize that it means that once the Spirit is present in your life, these qualities will begin to show in your life on their own rather than you having to try and force them!

We can spread love, joy, and all the other awesome fruits wherever we go, just by following where the Spirit leads us! When you do, you'll be amazed how much brighter the world around you becomes!

WHERE DOES THE POWER COME FROM? It is a common experience. You buy a new water heater, and it needs to be hard-wired directly into the main electrical system. You get it hooked up and turn it on. You've got the power! But where did it come from?

You may be like me and not know much about the whole process. You know when you plug an electronic device into the wall socket that it is connected to the circuit breaker box. The main power line comes to the house from the pole, which has been run from the local power substation. I don't know how all of that works (not a clue), and I don't need to know. All I know is that when I plug something in, there should be power!

Take this and make a spiritual application: The Almighty God in heaven is all-powerful (Jeremiah 32:17). He made all things, and He sustains all things (Psalms 33:6, 9). God has the power to forgive me of all sins (Matthew 9:6). God has the power to help me through all my trials and troubles (2 Chronicles 25:8). God has the power to hear all of the prayers and pleadings that I make and know all things happening in my life (Matthew 6:8). God has all the power!
