

NEW SERMON SERIES: JOHN 3:16! People often enjoy discussing who or what is "the greatest" in different areas of life. A new acronym has arisen in light of that: "GOAT," which stands for "Greatest of All Time." The first time I saw that, it was attributed to Tom Brady, who played into his mid-40s and has won more Super Bowls than any other quarterback in history, so he has been labeled "The GOAT." Others have been called "the greatest" of this or that in many different fields, but what about the Bible? What might the greatest verse in the Bible be? What would you say that it is? Poll after poll, survey after survey, consistently says that ONE verse is considered to be the "greatest verse of scripture" in the Bible: John 3:16. Is it really the greatest verse? Greatness, like beauty, might be in the eye of the beholder, but I think you can certainly make a case that it could be the greatest verse. You see it on billboards, signs at sports games and just about everywhere. Whether you know nothing of the Bible or everything in it, it's the best news ever for your life and the lives you touch! John 3:16 is considered the Mount Everest of Scripture. Why? John 3:16 shows us:

- The greatest motivation "For God so loved the world ..."
- The greatest sacrifice "That He gave His one and only Son..."
- The greatest invitation "That whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."

It is unbelievable – that God would love us so much that he chose to rescue us through the gift of His Son, Jesus – while we were unlovable people! John 3:16 offers us the hope of everlasting life – the promise alone should cause us to sing joyfully at the top of our lungs! Make sure to be present every Sunday as we look at this great verse starting today! He Loves! He Gave! We Believe!
