Today, several families are not here at Richland Road because we are participating in the Miami Valley Bible Bowl activities at the Centerville church of Christ. Our congregation has five teams that are participating. In addition, our family (Ben, Emily, Carol and myself) are the ones in charge of this event.

For those who are not familiar with what the Bible Bowl is all about, it is an opportunity to study a book of the Bible each year and then display your knowledge by competing in question and answer games. On Saturday (yesterday), we do four rounds of 25 multiple-choice questions in which the players choose the correct answer. Scoring is done individually and by teams, so players who answer the most correctly can win MVP awards, while the higher scoring teams get to start the second day with a higher seed in the tournament.

On Sunday, the teams compete in a Jeopardy or In the Know style buzzer round. As a question is asked, a player can buzz in and the first to answer correctly wins the points. It is set up like a tournament bracket so that in each division a champion is named at the end.

This is the 39th year that this particular Bible Bowl competition has been done. Our family began leading it in 2019.

Why do we do it? Here's why this event is important to me:

1. Everyone involved gains a deeper understanding of God's word. I've learned so much from the book of Luke by teaching it and by writing the competition questions.
2. This is a great opportunity to meet and form relationships with Christians from other churches. There are great brothers and sisters in Christ that I look forward to seeing this weekend and will enjoy seeing again when we all get to Heaven!
3. We live in a world that throws so much garbage at us. Isn't it great to know that our young believers have been setting that aside and focusing on God's word? Any opportunity for that to happen is a win.
