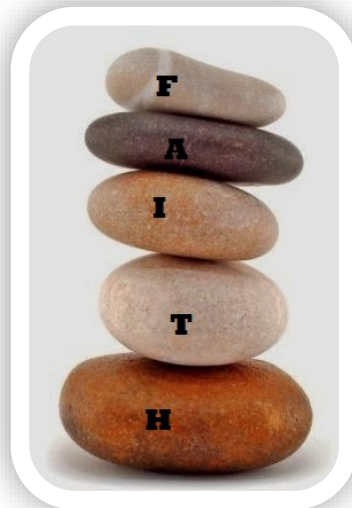

Hi Kids!

In the bulletin last week, Brian wrote about one of my favorite stories in the New Testament. It's about an absolutely amazing late-night prison escape! The apostle Peter, who had been put in jail for preaching the good news about Jesus, was miraculously escorted from his cell by an angel sent from God while, at the same time, Peter's friends were praying for him to be released! It was so amazing that even the people who saw it happen couldn't believe it was true! Peter didn't even think it was actually true! The Bible says he thought he was just having a weird dream!

Thinking of that brought to mind another story that starts out in a prison but ends up very differently. In Acts, a few chapters after the story of Peter, there were two men named Paul and Silas who had also been thrown in jail for preaching about Jesus. That night, just as before, God heard their prayer and sent such a powerful earthquake that the doors of the prison flew open, and the chains on all the prisoners were shaken off! But this time, there wasn't an escape. Instead, Paul and Silas managed to talk all the other prisoners into staying and hearing more about the gospel. Even the man in charge of the prison realized that Paul and Silas were very special men from God!

It's interesting to me that in each of these stories, God answered prayer about a very similar situation in two very different ways! In one case, Peter walked out of the prison as free as a bird to do more very important work for the cause of Christ, but in the other story, Paul and Silas actually stayed in prison where they also did very important work for Jesus! It reminds me that God always answers prayer, and even if it isn't always what we think we want at the time, it is always exactly the answer we need!
