One moment stood out to me in particular. I met a teenage camper from Michigan. At first, she looked at me as the “old dishwasher guy,” and you could see it in her eyes—*Why am I talking to him?* I wanted to break the ice, so I asked, “Do you know Dinah?” She hesitantly said yes. Then I asked, “How about Loey?” Another yes, a bit more curious. “Do you know Magi?” Now she looked truly puzzled.
