Staying Connected

DEVO & HOG ROAST! I hope you will join us tonight for our annual devotional and Hog Roast, as we kick off VBS week. Please bring two side dishes and a dessert.

UNDER CONSTRUCTION! I hope you are making plans to join us this week (Monday-Thursday) for Vacation Bible School. Our theme is *Under Construction: God at Work!* There will be classes for ALL ages (including adults). It seems like Ohio has five seasons: winter, spring, summer, fall, and construction. You cannot drive around our city, county, or state without seeing orange barrels and cones. As I travel through construction zones, the thought came to me that the life of a Christian is somewhat similar. If we're growing in the Lord, we are under construction to be the people He calls us to be. I want to share with you three 'caution' signs we need to be aware of regarding our spiritual construction zone.

#1: It is messy work! Road construction is a messy business. It involves tearing up old pavement, moving dirt, laying down new pavement, and other dirty, dusty work. So it is with us. Tearing out the old of sin and self (Ephesians 4:22, Colossians 3:5-9) and laying down the new of righteousness, holiness, and truth (Ephesians 4:24, Colossians 3:10).

#2: Get ready for delays! Road construction can occur on any stretch of road, bringing delays to our travel. Our spiritual construction zone is also filled with numerous delays. There are often delays in building our knowledge of Christ (2 Peter 3:18) and delays in letting that knowledge truly transform our lives (Romans 12:2).

#3: Don't quit! Whether it is due to unforeseen circumstances, such as weather or materials being delayed, or other things, construction workers often work long shifts. Many of them might feel like throwing up their hands in disgust and quit. But if they did that, our roads would be left in an awful mess, and we would never see the end of the orange barrels. If you're getting tired of the long, messy work of renovating your heart, or impatient with the spiritual progress you're making, don't give up, give in, or give out. Recall the words of Paul in Philippians 3:12 & 14, "Not that I have already obtained it or have already become perfect, but I press on...toward the goal of the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus."

Just like the roadwork going on around us, one day our own construction project will be complete, and we will enjoy what has been built. Until then, let us heed the 'Caution' signs.
